NATHANIEL SEBRELL

Tavern Owner, Hog Island, Virginia 1749-51

Nathaniel Sebrell was born in 1723⁶⁷ and died in Surry County, Virginia about 1816⁶⁸, son of Susanna Sebrell. He married first Catherine (---)⁶⁹ who died in 1752. He married second, Elizabeth Faulcon, daughter of Nicholas Faulcon of Surry County, Virginia.⁷⁰

A license was granted to Nathaniel to keep an ordinary on Hog Island, Surry County, Virginia.⁷¹

Nathaniel served as pall bearer at Elizabeth Stith's funeral at Bacon's Castle, 1774.⁷² He and his second wife had seven children whose descendants migrated throughout the country. However, one line went to Southampton, Virginia and remained there to the present.
